



## Program Overview

- **Program Name:** 4YOUTH outreach report
- **Date:** 17<sup>TH</sup> July 2025 – 17:30 –18:40
- **Location:** Portreath Village
- **Target Group:** Young people who are in the village at time of the visit.

The primary goal of this outreach initiative is to try and reduce anti-social behaviour in the village and sources ideas regarding what can be offered to engage young people. Also to encourage community awareness.

## Key Achievements and Outcomes

- **Total Number of Participants:** 8 young people
- **Gender :** 4 boys 4 girls
- **Demographic :** Portreath, Redruth, Pool
- **Ages :** Between the aged of 9 and 14

During our visit, we engaged with a group of boys and girls in the local park. The young people were playing together positively and were open and enthusiastic in their interactions with us. They came from a variety of nearby areas but reported that they frequently spend time in the village.

In conversation, they raised concerns about recent disturbances in the village, noting that these incidents can sometimes make them feel uncertain or reluctant to visit. We provided an overview of our current work in the area, which they received positively. They expressed appreciation for the increased presence of supportive adults. The interaction concluded with a shared game of Uno, after which we continued our walk through the village.



The wider village area was calm and relaxed. A small group of young people were observed on the beach, engaged in a game of football. They appeared content and there were no issues of concern.
