

CHAIRMANS REPORT November 3rd. 2025

1. The Clerk & I met with the Cornwall Highways Manager, Jack Thomas to discuss various highways issues in the parish that have been brought to our attention by parishioners. This was very productive and it was agreed to hold such meetings on a regular basis. Also present was a representative from the EA to discuss the potential highways issues that may arise if the flood prevention scheme goes ahead. One item that Jack introduced was that requests for highways improvements in 2026/27 are going to be asked for in the next few weeks. Would all councillors please think about what highways improvements they would like and we can then bid for them through our divisional councillor as soon as the window opens. He also told us of his aspirations to improve the multi use trails in the area. Locally for us - the extension of the Tolgus trail from Cornwall Gold up into Redruth
