

Chairmans report June 2026

1. ASB. On May 15th I met with the Chairman of the PIC, the local police sergeant and the lady who locks/unlocks Greenslade Gardens to discuss the anti social behaviour that has resumed happening there and see if our own youth initiative could help with the situation. Since that time, the ASB has gotten to a point where the PIC has felt the need to completely close the park due to the behaviour of a minority of youths that were making the situation potentially unsafe for their employee. At least one young person has been identified and details have been forwarded to the police. The CPR police team have now identified Portreath as a priority location and are increasing their patrols as & when resources allow. They want all members of the public to report all issues seen. Photographic evidence is good provided nobody puts themselves in harms way by taking such photos.
2. When the new lamppost was installed at the bus stop outside of the parish community hub/ Pod Café the waste bin that was attached to the old one was not put back in position. I made a personal report on the CC website about this and have received a reply stating they are no longer able to put bins on lamp posts. The waste contracts officer has however offered to install a 50 litre pavement mounted bin in its place outside the community hub, if we agree to a suitable location. on our land.
3. On a separate waste issue, I contacted the waste contracts officer to ask for extra temporary bins to be placed at the car park bus stop to cater for the extra waste that accumulates from the beach users now that the summer season is upon us, as was done previously. (At the start of the Bank holiday weekend the bins were overflowing into the bus bay and road) The reply was that they will monitor the situation as the season progresses and will install some extra bins, if the situation demands it.
4. A meeting with the Highways Manager has been arranged at the parish office at 1300 on Thursday June 4th. All councillors are encouraged to attend to discuss all highway issues and concerns that they may have. ***This is not a public meeting.***
