Please can you address our concerns regarding: the proposed Portreath Flood Alleviation Scheme?

2. There will also be a health risk to us as there will be sewerage/debris constantly sat in the water directly in front and probably under our house?
3. Where is the result of the core sample from our foundations ?
3. There will be sewerage on the beach, impacting on health and Biodiversity?
4. What are you planning on doing to offset the destruction of natural habitat and biodiversity when the green corridor on Tregaea Terrace and Glenfeadon is obliterated ?
5. There is a lack of parking in portreath and your scheme will increase this issue impacting further more on the residents here?
6. We are concerned SWW will take advantage of this scheme to consistently release sewage overflow into stream and not repair/ increase the capacity of the tunnel that at least takes it out to sea?
