The meeting noted the proposed lay in an area of common land and noted the comments of the of the Commons and Greens Registration Officer on the planning portal.

Members of Portreath Parish Council Unanimously **RESLOVED** to support this proposal

The meeting noted the strong objections of the public on the planning portal.

Members unanimously **RESOLVED** to suspend standing orders to allow a member of the public to speak on the proposal.

The planning agent present gave advice on 'Planning in Principle' applications.

Members unanimously **RESOLVED** reinstate standing orders.

Following debate Members of Portreath Parish **RESOLVED** to support the proposal but to reserve the right withdraw support when a full planning application is submitted. One member objected to this proposal

- iii) [PA26/04844 | New build holiday development. | Mount Warning North Coast Holiday Cottages New Portreath Road Redruth Cornwall TR16 4FW](#)

Cllr Hitchen declared an interest in this application and left the meeting room.

Councillors debated the proposal and expressed concern that curtilage of the property now extended onto agricultural land. Councillors suggested that there was adequate land to the east, west and south of the development to provide a garden area without the need to encroach on the agricultural land.

Members of Portreath Parish Council **RESLOVED** to object to the garden area extending onto agricultural land and request that the garden area is reinstated back to agricultural land. One councillor objected to this proposal.

Councillor Hitchen returned to the meeting.
