- **Program Name:** 4YOUTH outreach report
- **Date:** June 20th, 2025 – 16:30 – 17:40
- **Location:** Portreath Village
- **Target Group:** Young people who are in the village at time of the visit.

The primary goal of this outreach initiative is to try and reduce anti-social behaviour in the village and sources ideas regarding what can be offered to engage young people. Also to encourage community awareness.

Key Achievements and Outcomes

We engaged with a small group of young people at the park, they were very relaxed and playing football, no problems while we were there. We walked the village and went to the Beach, there was a larger group of young people on the beach by the lifeguard hut they recognised us from last week and engaged in general conversation, we reminded them to take their rubbish to the bin, they were mostly heading into the sea so we were unable to carry on conversation from last week regarding activities to engage them. We will follow this up on our next session.

We introduced ourselves to the RLNI on duty by the sea and advised them of our plan. They didn't have anything to report regarding anti-social behaviour up to that point in the day.
