Location: Portreath Village

 Target Group: Young people who are in the village at time of the visit.

The primary goal of this outreach initiative is to try and reduce anti-social behaviour in the village and sources ideas regarding what can be offered to engage young people. Also to encourage community awareness.

Key Achievements and Outcomes

• Total Number of Participants: 40 young people

• Gender: 30 boys 10 girls

• Demographic: Portreath, Redruth, St Day, Blackwater and Troon

• Ages: Between the aged of 10 and 17

We engaged with a large group of young people who were at the Harbour, some were jumping into the sea at the end and others were just sat down listing to music and socialising with each other others were in the actual harbour finding shells. We had a wide range of conversations.

We offered safety advice to them all and we monitored them for quite sometime. They all engaged with myself and my worker, they were very relaxed, and they talked about the use of mopeds in the village and how they get annoyed with people driving through the village fast on. We talked about the bus they use to get home, they all said that it can be pretty crazy at times. We talked about appropriate behaviour and how things impact the village. They all listened and feedback they haven't even thought about the impact on the village.

When we were leaving there was 2 younger young people jumping off the Crane, we stopped to talk to them and advised them to not jump



from it, unfortunately they chose to ignore any advice and continued to jump.

They were all polite and relaxed, there was no rubbish around at the time of our visit and it was a great session. The young people asked us to come back again to see them.
