Program Name: 4YOUTH outreach report

• **Date**: August 17th 15:30-16:40

Location: Portreath Village

Target Group: Young people who are in the village at time of the visit.

The primary goal of this outreach initiative is to try and reduce anti-social behaviour in the village and sources ideas regarding what can be offered to engage young people. Also to encourage community awareness.

Key Achievements and Outcomes

• Total Number of Participants: 8 young people

• **Gender**: 5 boys 3 girls

• **Demographic**: Portreath, Redruth, Camborne and London.

• Ages: Between the aged of 6 and 14

We engaged with young people in the park, where we promoted the upcoming summer activities. Several were on holiday and unfamiliar with the sea, so we provided guidance on sea safety. We also interacted with younger children through a game of Uno, which supported relationship building.

Following this, we moved to the beach and village areas. Engagement was limited, but we spoke with two young people near the beach steps, discussing their summer plans and further promoting the activities. One recognised us from previous sessions, indicating continuity of contact.

Overall, the session was quiet but positive, with meaningful interactions and reinforcement of key messages.
