- **Program Name:** 4YOUTH outreach report
- **Date:** July 19th, 2026 – 11:00- 12:15
- **Location:** Portreath Village
- **Target Group:** Young people who are in the village at time of the visit.

The primary goal of this outreach initiative is to try and reduce anti-social behaviour in the village and sources ideas regarding what can be offered to engage young people. Also to encourage community awareness.

Key Achievements and Outcomes

- **Total Number of Participants:** 7 young people
- **Gender :** 5 boys 2 girls
- **Demographic :** Portreath, Redruth, Camborne and Kent.
- **Ages :** Between the aged of 9 and 14

We spoke with young people in the park and promoted the upcoming summer activities. We discussed our summer plans, including Chips and Chill, and they showed interest in both opportunities.

We encouraged them to pick up the rubbish around them and reminded them that the park is a shared space.

We then visited the shop to gather an update. Staff reported a few issues, but nothing major. We also spoke with people at the bakery before walking to the beach, where we met several local community members and promoted our sessions and summer programme.

Overall, the session was quiet but positive, with meaningful interactions and clear reinforcement of key messages.
