

## **Chairmans report July 2025**

1. I attended the first CAP meeting of the new term of councils (and councillors). The representatives of the towns/parishes has more or less remained the same, but the divisional councillors are all new. New chairs and vice chairs were voted in with Bob Drew of Carn Brea taking over as Chairman. Personally, I have agreed to continue as one of the members of the CAP funding panel. The meeting primarily dealt with discussions around what the priorities should be for the CAP to focus upon. Various proposals were put forward and when all these are collated, a short list will be drawn up to be agreed at the next meeting in September. I'm fairly certain that "Youth" will be one.
2. I attended the quarterly meeting of the MVRG and presented the background to our application for a grant towards the funding of the youth worker we have employed. I'm pleased to say that this was agreed unanimously and the MVRG will match our own expenditure.
3. Yet again – regarding youth – I attended a meeting last week with the various stakeholders to evaluate the problems the village is suffering with ASB. Lucy will provide a fuller description of that in her clerks report.
4. Tomorrow evening, I will be at the WAAF Site working group meeting to discuss the progress of the investigations that the various members having been carrying out to be able to aid the council in making a decision on the future of the site.
