Youth Nights

The Youth Working Group met in November, which was a positive meeting. Changes were made and agreed to the Action Plan. Please find this in the papers for your information.

Community Junior Netball

We have had 3 successful sessions to date. We have 30 young people who are booked into each session, and we currently have 3 young people on the waiting list, with 3 enquiries but which have not turned into bookings.

We have 8 fantastic Volunteers, who all have varying levels of netball experience. Our coaches are the most experienced, who currently play and compete netball and includes a trained umpire, to our helpers, who have experience of netball but haven't played in many years. They all bring positive attitudes and commitment to engaging with the young people. They have been a resounding success so far, with no first aid incidents.

All our volunteers have been through the DBS checks. One of our volunteers has signed up to a First Aid Course on the 27th January 2023.

We have received positive feedback from the parents. We have asked the young people a few very short questions before/after sessions 1&2 and will ask the same questions in sessions 5 or 6 and then at the final session. This is to collect data on the impact the netball sessions have had on the young people.

To date, I have not been able to secure anything beyond April. I am hopeful that I can get a group of people to take this on and will be working on this specifically, in the 3 week gap that we have been 24th January and the 20th February.

The volunteers have asked if they are able to arrange a friendly match, if they can arrange one. I have advised I'd need to get full council backing.

Proposal: Would the council support this activity, if it is covered by our insurance and is fully risk assessed? If the council agree, this would be arranged to take place in April. It should not incur any additional costs.
