JANUARY LITTER PICK

This was well attended with new volunteers and lots of rubbish was collected. There had been further fly tipping on Lighthouse Hill so Cornwall Council were notified and it was cleared within 24 hours. Excellent result.

MEETING WITH PERRAN MOON

Representatives of Love Portreath joined the 2 hour walk from the Pumping Station to Tregea Terrace along with reps from PPC, Portreath Flood Resilience Action Group and the EA. This was an informative and illuminating meeting, Perran has promised to look into the issue of surface water drainage along Tregea Terrace and how this impacts the scheme, and also to look into the lack of suds implementation in Redruth which was raised by LP at our meeting with him in November. Evidence was given to him at that meeting that best practice had not been followed and that there has been joining of sewage and surface water drainage pipes.

LP will be contacting Perran to ensure these actions are pursued.

WAAF SITE

Members of LP have volunteered to be part of a Friends of the WAAF group or a PC sub group to improve biodiversity in a light touch approach. This option was the recommendation of the Working Group but has not as yet ratified by full council due to the necessity of a report into the PC'S responsibility for public liability as owners of the site. This report should be available this month.

NEW INITIATIVES FOR 2026

Various new initiatives will be discussed, including a community sustainable venture. This would be a monthly event similar to the former Portreath Pantry which was very successful and well supported. Food would be locally sourced where possible and this would be a low impact project.

A joint venture with St Mary's Church regarding a greener approach to cleaning products, composting etc has also been suggested.
