The PLG meeting was held on Monday 27th March 2023.

The meeting covered current issues in Camborne, which don't directly affect our Parish. However, these covered Anti-Social Behaviour of young people, issues with Electric Scooters and that a new Licence Officer is now in post, who is very pro-active.

Would like to encourage ALL members of the public to REPORT any offence that takes place. This is crucial in assisting the police to build evidence of criminal activity and taking action.

Redruth – No current issues.

Cllr Barbara Ellenbroek advised that there are meetings taking place, between Cornwall Council and other organisations around youth provision in the Redruth area. Outreach workers have been out talking with young people in Redruth and the main theme is that they would like somewhere they can all meet up.
