

POLICY 5. CHANGING HOW WE MOVE AROUND

The Parish Council will work to help reduce dependency on fossil fuels for travel and improve safety and accessibility of pedestrian and cycle routes.

It will strive to

- Encourage the use of public transport and lobby Cornwall Council for improved bus services to and from the parish.
- Promote the reduction of car use. Encourage car sharing. Explore possibility of facilitating a commercial car club.
- Promote cycling and walking (including walk to school initiatives)
- Provide more cycle parking
- Improve safety. Slow vehicles down, maintain safe walking and cycling paths and keep road signage clear
- Consider weight/size restrictions for heavy goods vehicles travelling through the parish
- Lobby for safe road crossings particularly at the school entrance and between the beach and the public conveniences.
- Provide safe and accessible routes connecting key attractions. For example, from Tregea Park to the beach. Lighthouse Hill to the harbour. Portreath to Redruth
- Support the Mining Trail forum in promoting and maintaining routes
- Improve signage to, and on, all safe routes
- Encourage the use of electric cars. Aspire to all new buildings having sufficient charging points to meet future needs. Consider sites for communal charging points for homes without off road parking, and for visitors.
- Support the work of the Carbon Action Network in community-led initiatives
