### **Proposed Pedestrian Crossing Facility at Sea Front, Portreath**

Cormac Solutions Ltd, on behalf of Cornwall Council, is inviting comments on a proposal to construct improved pedestrian crossing facilities on the Sea Front road, Portreath. Funding for the improvement has been obtained through the Community Area Partnership.

The beach, car park and some food outlets are on the opposite side of the road to where the public toilets are situated. To get to and from the toilets, users of the beach areas have to cross the road where there is no pedestrian crossing. In the height of Summer, especially, with the high volume of traffic and a large amount of Blue Badge holders parking outside the toilets, crossing the road becomes very hazardous.

On the east side of the road, the kerb and footway will be lowered to carriageway level. On the opposite side - where there is an existing dropped kerb - we will construct two traffic islands to protect the dropped kerb from obstruction by parked vehicles.

If constructed, this pedestrian safety improvement will contribute to Goals 5 and 6 of the Cornwall Transport Plan Vision:

5. Ensure our communities are safer and more enjoyable places to live by reducing the negative impacts of transport;
6. Improve access for everyone, regardless of age, postcode, income level or ability.
